OUR MISSION

The Quell Foundation strives to reduce the number of suicides, overdoses, and incarcerations of people with mental health illness. We work to accomplish this by encouraging people to share their stories, increasing access to mental health services, providing a pipeline of future mental health care professionals with scholarships, and training first responders to recognize mental health crisis warning signs amongst their own.

There's a severe stigma associated with mental health illness that prevents those closest to us from getting the help they need. By promoting open, judgment-free dialogue, together we can shatter the stigma and normalize the conversation around mental health.

THE AWARD

The Quell Fighter Scholarship is awarded to a select high school senior or a current undergraduate/graduate student that is being treated for a diagnosed mental health condition. The award was established by The Quell Foundations Awareness Fund as a means to create a paradigm shift in the care and treatment of people with mental health illness.

This important recognition is accompanied with:

- A one-year distribution of a \$500 - \$1,500 scholarship.
- Opportunity to participate in the foundation's awareness events/activities.

Application deadline is April 15, 2019

ELIGIBILITY & RENEWAL REQUIREMENTS

The Quell Foundation Fighter Scholarship is a one-time, merit-based award. Awards will be made to those students who demonstrate a high level of scholarship and/or a history of employment and training that reflects a commitment to work.

To be eligible, you must meet the following criteria:

- Student must live with a diagnosed mental health condition, as documented by a mental health care professional.
- Student must be accepted into an accredited College or University.
- Student must be matriculated and maintain at least part-time enrollment in an undergraduate/graduate program.
- Students must obtain a passing grade in all classes.
- Students must maintain a minimum GPA of 2.70 each Financial Aid Year.
- Award must be applied to degree granting institution within academic year 2019-2020.
- Student will be encouraged to help facilitate showing of the Foundation's, Lift the Mask documentary on their college campus and participate in community awareness events/activities.
- Award recipients must adhere to all behavioral, professional and ethical guidelines set forth by the educational institution.
- Award recipients must demonstrate an understanding and commitment to The Quell Foundation's Mission.
- Following award notification, recipients will be encouraged to submit a headshot and/or 20 second thank you video

FIGHTER SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM

1. Complete all sections of the application form.
2. Provide an electronic copy of a college/university transcript from the most recent academic work.
3. Write a personal statement describing your reasons for pursuing a degree. The essay should be approximately 500 words and should include information regarding your career goals, interests and work experiences (paid or volunteer), as well as any additional information that provides some insight about your commitment to maintaining your mental health.
4. Provide electronic documentation from an accredited mental health professional attesting to your current treatment for a mental health condition. Diagnosis is NOT required.
5. Obtain two (2) letters of recommendation from individuals who are familiar with your academic and/or professional skills and experiences. Letters must be attached electronically. Please note, this is for first-time applicants only.
